Luciana C. de Oliveira, Ph.D. is Professor and Chair in the Department of Teaching and Learning in the School of Education and Human Development at the University of Miami, Florida. Her current research focuses on issues related to teaching English language learners (ELLs) at the K-12 level, including the role of language in learning the content areas and teacher education, advocacy and social justice. Currently, Dr. de Oliveira's research examines scaffolding in first grade classrooms and multimodal representation in picture books. She is the author or editor of 18 books and over 150 publications in various outlets. She is the series editor of five volumes focused on the Common Core State Standards and ELLs (2014-2016) with TESOL Press. In addition, her latest books include *Teaching science to English language learners: Preparing pre-service and in-service teachers* (Palgrave Macmillan, 2017; co-edited with Kristen C. Wilcox); *Teaching English language arts to English language learners: Preparing pre-service and in-service teachers* (Palgrave Macmillan, 2016; co-edited with Melanie Shoffner); *Focus on Grammar and Meaning* (Oxford University Press, 2015; co-authored with M. Schleppegrell); *Preparing Teachers to Work with English Language Learners in Mainstream Classrooms* (TESOL Press and Information Age Publishing, 2015; co-edited with M. Yough); and *Second Language Writing in Elementary Classrooms: Instructional Issues, Content-Area Writing, and Teacher Education* (Palgrave Macmillan, 2016; co-edited with T. Silva).
